AWT Legionella 2003 states "Legionella Testing is a [ProActive](#) Choice: There is no risk for Legionnaires' disease if there is no Legionella."

"The only (practical) way to know you have Legionella is to test for it."

[ProAsys](#) recommends twice annual sampling for all cooling tower systems.

ZEROoutbreak

Since Legionella exists in most aquatic habitats (lakes, rivers, streams, etc.), the occasional presence of Legionella in building water systems should be considered a normal occurrence.

Regulatory agencies have established [action levels](#) and guidelines which target zero cases of Legionnaires' disease not zero Legionella.



Possible Exposure Pathways

In addition to cooling tower systems, potential areas where Legionella bacteria can grow and/or spread include:

- Showers/Faucets
- Hot Tubs/Spas
- Humidifiers/Misters
- Decorative Fountains
- Drinking Water
